

ORDINANCE NO. 88-6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW BERLIN, UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING THE OPEN BURNING OF ALL SUBSTANCES WITHIN THE BOROUGH; AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Mayor of the Borough Council of the Borough of New Berlin, Union County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION ONE

BURNING LEAVES, REFUSE AND GARBAGE

(a) It shall be unlawful to burn any garbage or other organic refuse, (i.e., leaves, grass, etc.) that smolders or give off noxious odors outside of any building at anytime within the Borough.

(b) It shall be unlawful to burn papers, or other material which may be blown about by the wind within the Borough unless the same is burned in a stove, fireplace or furnace, or in an incinerator sufficiently constructed to prevent the escape of ignited sparks or other particles into the air. It shall be unlawful to permit the escape of soot, ashes or other solid products or results of combustion so as to be wind blown or scattered.

(c) It shall be lawful to burn allowable materials on Monday through Saturday, inclusive, from 6:00 A.M. to one hour before sundown prevailing time.

SECTION TWO

BURNING RESTRICTIONS

(a) No person shall kindle or maintain any bonfire or other fire, or authorize such fire to be kindled or maintained on or in any public street, alley, road, sidewalk or public ground or so close to any building or other structure as to endanger such building or structure.

(b) During construction or demolition of buildings or structure no waste materials or rubbish shall be disposed of by burning on the premises or in the immediate vicinity without having obtained the approval of the Borough Building Code Enforcement Officer.

SECTION THREE

Any person or corporation violating any provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

SECTION FOUR


If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.

SECTION FIVE


All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are repealed.
