ORDINANCE NO. 72-4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW BERLIN, UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING CHERRY STREET AS A ONE-WAY STREET FROM MAIZE ALLEY TO MARKET STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of New Berlin, Union County, Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION 1. Cherry Street is hereby established as a one-way street, from Maize Alley to Market Street, vehicular traffic to move in a south-bound direction only.

SECTION 2. Any person who shall operate a vehicle on Cherry Street in violation of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Ten Dollars (\$10) and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to be imprisoned in the County jail for a term not to exceed five (5) days.

SECTION 3. Action taken by Borough Council by Resolution on December 3, 1969 with respect to the subject of this Ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 4. Any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with this Ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same is inconsistent herewith.
