

ORDINANCE NO. 85-3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW BERLIN, UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE RATE OF COMPENSATION OF BOROUGH COUNCILMEN AND THE MAYOR

Be it enacted and ordained by the Mayor and Town Council of the Borough of New Berlin, Union County, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1: The compensation of each individual councilmen of the Borough of New Berlin, is hereby fixed at Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars per month, commencing with the calendar year 1985.

Section 2: The compensation of the Mayor of the Borough of New Berlin, is hereby vixed at Twenty (\$20.00) Dolalrs per month, commencing with the calendar year 1985.

Section 3: The aforesaid compensation shall be paid from the Borough Treasury in semi-annual installments.

Section 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This ordinance shall take effect immediatley upon enactment.

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT ORDINANCE
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Borough Council of the Borough of New Berlin, Union County, Pennsylvania, will hold a public hearing prior to its regular meeting on Wednesday, February 13, 1985, at 7:00 o'clock P.M. in the meeting room above the fire house, High Street, New Berlin, for the purpose of consideration and acting upon ordinances No. 85-1 and 85-2 and 85-3 a summary of which is as follows:
ORDINANCE NO. 85-1. Levying a tax on property and occupants in the amount of 7.2 mills for real estate on each dollar of assessed valuation, 22 mills personal tax, levying on earned income and wage tax on all residents in the amount of one percent, levying an occupation privilege tax in the amount of \$10.00 for engaging in an occupation within the corporate limits of the Borough, levying a realty transfer tax of one percent upon the transferee of the value of real property or interest therein situate within borough limits.
ORDINANCE NO. 85-2. Prohibiting parking on the west side of Walnut Street from 31st Street to Market Street, including the erection and maintenance of signs indicating there are no parking areas, and providing for penalties for the violation of this ordinance.
ORDINANCE NO. 85-3. Extending the rate of compensation for the Borough Councilmen and the Borough Secretary.
