ORDINANCE NO. 72 - 5

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW BERLIN, UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW BERLIN, UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA RELATING TO THE DISTRIBUTION OF WATER FOR DOMESTIC, COMMERCIAL, BUSINESS AND OTHER USERS, FIXING THE TERMS AND RATES FOR WATER CONNECTIONS AND UPON WHICH WATER WILL BE FURNISHED TO THE PUBLIC, PRESCRIBING RATES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING THE SAME, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE SAME" APPROVED AUGUST 29, 1960, AS AMENDED, BY IMPOSING WATER RATES BASED ON METER READINGS, INCREASING TURN OFF AND TURN ON CHARGES, AND LIMITING THE SIZE OF THE WATER METER PROVIDED FREE OF CHARGE BY THE BOROUGH.

The Borough Council of the Borough of New Berlin, Union County, Pennsylvania hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of "An Ordinance of the Borough of New Berlin, Union County, Pennsylvania, relating to the distribution of water for domestic, commercial business and other users, fixing the terms and rates for water connections and upon which water will be furnished to the public, prescribing rules and regulations regarding the same, and prescribing penalties for the violation of the same" approved August 29, 1960, as amended, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"Section 2. Metered Water Rates: All rates charged for water furnished to consumers in the Borough of New Berlin shall be on the basis of quarterly meter readings, in accordance with the following schedule:

<u>Quarterly Water Consumption</u>	<u>Quarterly Billing</u>
1st 9,000 gallons	\$11.00 minimum charge
Next 6,000 gallons	1.20/ 1,000 gals.
Next 15,000 gallons	1.15/ 1,000 gals.
Over 30,000 gallons	1.05/ 1,000 gals."

SECTION 2. Section 5 of the aforesaid Ordinance approved August 29, 1960, as amended, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"Section 5. New Connections: Any person or party desiring a new service connection to the Water System shall file an application therefor with the Borough Secretary together with the connection fee of \$150.00, which fee shall pay for a connection from the water

main to a curb stop located between the curb line and the sidewalk line as well as a water meter. It shall be the responsibility of the occupant to provide the necessary water service from the curb stop to the building to be serviced. The Borough shall be required to provide for said connection fee a three-quarter inch water line and a five-eighth inch water meter. If the applicant desires a larger water line and a larger meter, he must so indicated on his application, and the applicant must pay, in addition to said connection fee, the difference in cost to the Borough between acquiring and installing the aforesaid three-quarter inch water line and five-eighth inch water meter and the size desired by the applicant."

SECTION 3. Section 6 of the aforesaid Water Ordinance of August 29, 1960, as amended, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"Section 6. Discontinuing and restoring service: A charge of \$5.00 payable in advance will be made in each instance for turning off and another \$5.00 for turning on water at the curb stop after service has been discontinued or reinstated at the request of the consumer, whatever the reason. A charge of \$25.00 payable in advance will be made for turning on water at the curb stop after service has been discontinued for any violation of this Ordinance. If service was discontinued for failure to pay charges, bills and assessments for water service, then said \$25.00 shall be in addition to any and all outstanding charges for water service, including penalties and interest thereon."

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon enactment, except that the water meter rates imposed under Section 2 of the Water Ordinance, as amended, shall be imposed commencing *October 1*, 1972, based upon the water meter readings for the *fourth* calendar quarter of 1972.

SECTION 5. Except as herein amended, said Ordinance approved August 29, 1960, as previously amended, shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE WAS ENACTED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW BERLIN, UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ON NOVEMBER 13, 1972.

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW BERLIN, UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEWBERLIN, UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA RELATING TO THE DISTRIBUTION OF WATER FOR DOMESTIC, COMMERCIAL, BUSINESS AND OTHER USERS, FIXING THE TERMS AND RATES FOR WATER CONNECTIONS AND UPON WHICH WATER WILL BE FURNISHED TO THE PUBLIC, PRESCRIBING RATES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING THE SAME, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE SAME" APPROVED AUGUST 29, 1960, AS AMENDED, BY IMPOSING WATER RATES BASED ON METER READINGS, INCREASING TURN OFF AND TURN ON CHARGES, AND LIMITING THE SIZE OF THE WATER METER PROVIDED FREE OF CHARGE BY THE BOROUGH.

The Borough Council of the Borough of New Berlin, Union County, Pennsylvania hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of "An Ordinance of the Borough of New Berlin, Union County, Pennsylvania, relating to the distribution of water for domestic, commercial business and other users, fixing the terms and rates for water connections and upon which water will be furnished to the public, prescribing rules and regulations regarding the same, and prescribing penalties for the violation of the same" approved August 29, 1960, as amended, is hereby

follows:

"Section 2. Metered Water Rates: All rates charged for water furnished to consumers in the Borough of New Berlin shall be on the basis of quarterly meter readings, in accordance with the following schedule:

The quarterly water consumption and quarterly billing is as follows: 1st 9,000 gallons, \$11.00 minimum charge; next 6,000 gallons, \$1.20/1,000 gals.; next 15,000 gallons, \$1.15/1,000 gals.; over 30,000 gallons, \$1.05/1,000 gals."

SECTION 2. Section 5 of the aforesaid Ordinance approved August 29, 1960, as amended, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"Section 5. New Connections: Any person or party desiring a new service connection to the Water System shall file an application therefor with the Borough Secretary together with the connection fee of \$150.00, which fee shall pay for a connection from the water main to a curb stop located between the curb line and the sidewalk line as well as a water meter. SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon enactment, except that the water meter rates imposed under Section 2 of the Water Ordinance, as amended, shall be imposed commencing October 1, 1972, based upon the water meter readings for the fourth calendar quarter of 1972.

SECTION 5. Except as herein amended, said Ordinance approved August 29, 1960, as previously amended, shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
