

ORDINANCE 2002-3

**ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 76-10, ESTABLISHING A
CURFEW FOR MINORS**

BEING ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of New Berlin, Union County, as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person under eighteen (18) years of age to remain on any public street, alley or public place in the Borough after 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m. of the next day, unless said minor is:

A. Accompanied by a parent or guardian or the person having custody of such minor;

B. In the performance of matter of necessity or emergency;

C. In lawful employment making it necessary to be in such place after 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m. of the next day.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for anyone having the legal care and custody of any such minor to allow such minor to allow or permit any such minor to go or be on any public street, alley or other public place in the Borough after 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m. of the next day, except as provided in the preceding section.

SECTION 3. Any person violating the provisions of Section 1 or Section 2 of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction in a summary proceeding before a magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$600.00 for each offense, plus the cost of prosecution. In default of such payment of such fines and costs, to be imprisoned for a period of not in excess of ten (10) days.

The balance of 76-10, except as amended herein, shall remain in full force and effect.

ENACTED AND ORDAINED this 8th day of May, 2002.
