

\$25.00 fee for a letter for delinquency


\$25.00 fee for the filing of a complaint before the Magistrate or a lien at the Courthouse

\$110.00 per hour fee for attend a Magistrate or Court hearing







- \$110.00 per hour fee for attend a Magistrate or Court hearing


