

ORDINANCE NO. 35-1-

Relative to fast and reckless driving on the streets of New Berlin, Union County, Pennsylvania, and the appointment of officers to enforce regulations.

BE it enacted and ordained by the burgess and Borough Council of the Borough of New Berlin, Pennsylvania, in Borough Council assembled, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful, to drive upon any of the streets of said Borough faster than twenty miles per hour, or to enter upon a street or highway, where a stop sign is erected, before coming to a full stop; to park within twenty feet of any fire hydrant or fire engine house, to park within any restricted area where proper signs are erected, by the Burgess and Council.

Section 2. That the present Borough Council and their successors in office, shall, appoint the Fire Police to act as Borough Police, at a salary of one dollar per year, whose duty it shall be to enforce this, as well as all ordinances of the Borough, when so ordered by the Burgess, Borough Council or the chief of police.

Any person found guilty of violating this ordinance shall pay a fine of five dollars and costs. The above fines to be collected before the Burgess or any Justice of the Peace, the same as other fines are by law recoverable. Said fines so received shall be paid into the Borough treasury.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this ordinance are repealed.
