



**MUNICIPAL RESOLUTION NO.** 2014-2

2. that the Legislative Body hereby designates the following persons and any Officers holding the following titles/positions







**RESOLUTION FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A BOARD OF APPEALS  
UNDER THE PENNSYLVANIA CONSTRUCTION CODE ACT**

**WHEREAS**, the Pennsylvania General Assembly adopted the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act on November 10, 1999, as Act 45 of 1999, which is codified at 35 P.S. §7210.101 et seq. (the "Act"), in order to create a statewide building code which would provide uniform standards for the protection of life, health, property and the environment and for the safety and welfare of the owners and occupants of buildings and structures; and

**WHEREAS**, at a meeting of the Borough of New Berlin, held on September 10, 2014, a quorum being present and voting, a resolution was adopted to appoint a Board of Appeals under the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act and Ordinance No. 1995-3 of this New Berlin (Township/Borough).

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Board of Appeals as established by the Central Keystone Council of Governments shall be the Board of Appeals for the Township/Borough. The Board of Appeals shall be made available to disseminate the following section(s) of the International Building Code: ICC Electrical Code, International Mechanical Code, International Fuel Gas Code, International Plumbing Code, International Residential Code, International Fire Code, International Energy Conservation Code, International Existing Building Code, International Urban-Wildland Interface Code, and the International Property Maintenance Code.

The within Resolution was enacted on September 10, 2014, at the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors/Council of Borough of New Berlin (Township/Borough), Union County, Pennsylvania.
