## AN ORDINANCE

## ORDINANCE NO. 38-1\_

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW BERLIN, UNION COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, fixing the tax rate and making appropriations for defraying the expenses of the Borough for the fiscal year beginning the first Monday of January 1938 and ending the first Monday of January 1939.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Burgess and Council of the Borough of New Berlin, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property and occupations within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1938 as follows:

Tax rate for general Borough purposes, the sum of 18 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

Making a total tax rate for all Borough purposes of 18 mills.

SECTION 2. That for defraying the expenses of said Borough for the fiscal year 1938, the following sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary as authorized by law, are hereby appropriated for the following uses:
