AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW BERLIN, UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ACCEPTING HAZEL STREET, AS PUBLIC HIGHWAYS.



SECTION ONE: Hazel Street in the Seminary Acres Development to the Borough of New Berlin, Union County, Pennsylvania, is hereby designated as being accepted and is hereby adopted as a public highway under the provisions of Section 1731 of the Borough Code.



NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Borough Council of the Borough of New Berlin, Union County, Pennsylvania, will hold a public hearing prior to its regular meeting on Wednesday, December 9, 1992, at 7:30 P.M., in the Community Center, New Berlin, for the purpose of consideration and acting upon an Amendment to the Zoning Ordinance for the Borough of New Berlin as follows:

ARTICLE II - DEFINITIONS

200 APPLICABLE DEFINITIONS

Stenographic Record of Proceedings: Making a permanent record of the proceedings either through a stenographer or by means of a mechanical or electronic device.

ARTICLE VII - ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT

710 HEARINGS

- C. The zoning hearing boards shall keep a stenographic record of the proceedings, either through a stenographer or by means of a mechanical or electronic device. The appearance fee for a stenographer shall be shared equally by the applicant and the zoning hearing board.

In all other respects, the provisions contained in the Zoning Ordinance for the Borough of New Berlin shall remain ratified and approved.


